Participants must come into the library to register and can begin reading and recording at that time. First completed logs will be accepted on Monday, June 15th or after.

The Teen Reading Club for teens ages 13 through 16

Those children, who are in the Read to Me Club, will have the title of the books someone reads to them recorded on a reading log. They will receive 5 raffle tickets for every completed log of 15 books read.

Children, in the Summer Reading Club and Teen Reading Club, will keep a log of the hours they read. They will receive 5 raffle tickets for every completed log of 5 hours they read. Participants can turn in their raffle tickets anytime with their name, phone number, and number of the prize they want to win.

Family Story hour will be held throughout the summer reading program on Thursdays. There will be two sessions, 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. for all ages. Sign up sheets will be posted one week in advance of each story time.
